## 40th Anniversary Poster Contest - Contest Guidelines

### **Who May Enter:**

Any individual or group who reside within the Town of Prescott Valley may enter.

### **Entry Divisions:**

- 2nd Grade and Under
- 3rd Grade through 6th Grade
- 7th & 8th Grades
- 9th Grade through 12th Grade
- Adult (18+)

### **Deadline for Entries:**

Entries must be received by Friday, January 12th, 2018.

### **Poster Theme:**

Poster content must be focused on "why I LOVE the Town of Prescott Valley" in celebration of its 40 years of operation, via text and images related to the Town, local history, citizens and organizations.

### **Contest Rules and Procedures:**

All posters must be of original art. All displays will meet existing local, state, and federal laws on obscenity, libel, defamation of character, or invasion of privacy.

Display materials must not contain text or graphics, or both, which:

- Is likely to incite or produce an imminent lawless act
- Disrupt the orderly operation of a Town facility
- Is integral to criminal conduct or is violation of the law
- Infringes on intellectual property right (e.g. copyright, patent, trade, or service mark)
- May reasonably be construed as false, fraudulent, or defamatory
- Obscene matter
- Harmful matter for minors

Entries are limited to a maximum of 18 x 24 inches and a minimum of 8.5 x 11 inches.

All 2-D work (paintings, drawings, photos, mixed media, etc.) will be accepted.

*All entries become property of the Town (for auctioning purposes, with recognition of contributing artist) and The Town reserves the right to photograph and/or have photographed all works of art for promotional and/or record keeping purposes*

### **Judging:**

Posters will be judged by a panel comprised of people from the Prescott Valley Arts and Culture Commission.

Posters will be judged based on the following criteria:

- Originality – How the idea is expressed in the poster design.
- Creativity – The subject matter depicted in the artwork and its execution.
- Visual Impact – How the design strikes the viewer and delivers a clear message consistent with the theme of the contest.

### **Prizes:**

The top ten (10) entries from each division will be displayed in the Prescott Valley Public Library throughout the month of February and will be recognized for their achievement at a scheduled Town Council meeting. The top three (3) entries from each division will be awarded art supply gift cards.
