By adopting a park, citizens are making their parks more beautiful, and are extending tax dollars by allowing park staff to focus on major renovation, repair and maintenance work.

### Memorial Tree Donation Program

The Memorial Tree Donation Program lets you remember a loved one in a very special way by planting a tree in his or her honor in one of the Town's parks. Your loved one will not only be remembered, but you'll be helping your community at the same time. As an added remembrance of your loved one, a plaque can be installed by the tree. The Memorial Tree and Plaque will be purchased from funds donated in your loved one's name. Memorial Tree planting process, you will need to complete a Memorial Tree Donation Program Application. Once your completed application and donation is received by the Town, the funds will be deposited into the Memorial Tree Program account in your loved one's name. A letter confirming the donation will be sent to the donor.
