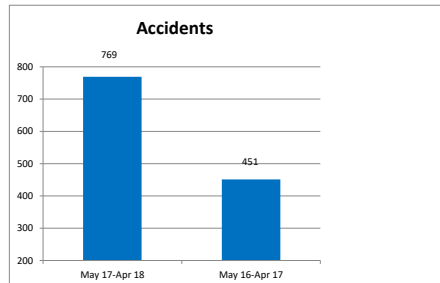
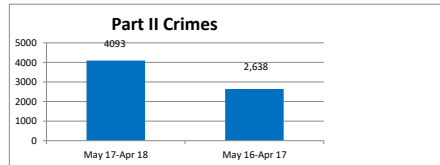
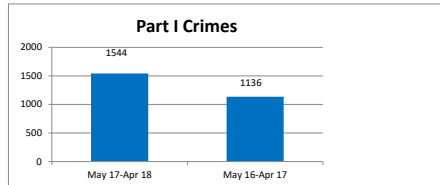

Part I Crimes	
<b>Criminal Homicide – Murder and Non Negligent Manslaughter</b>	<i>Definition:</i> The willful killing of one human being by another.
<b>Rape</b>	<i>Definition:</i> The carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will.
<b>Robbery</b>	<i>Definition:</i> The taking or attempting to take anything of value from the care, custody, or control of a person or persons by force or threat of force or violence and/or by putting the victim in fear.
<b>Aggravated Assault</b>	<i>Definition:</i> An unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe or aggravated bodily injury. This type of assault usually is accompanied by the use of a weapon or by means likely to produce death or great bodily harm.
<b>Burglary – Breaking or Entering</b>	<i>Definition:</i> The unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or a theft.
<b>Larceny – Theft</b>	<i>Definition:</i> The unlawful taking, carrying, leading or riding away of property from the possession or constructive possession of another.
<b>Motor Vehicle Theft</b>	<i>Definition:</i> The theft of attempted theft of a motor vehicle.
<b>Arson</b>	<i>Definition:</i> Any willful or malicious burning or attempt to burn, with or without intent to defraud, a dwelling house, public building, motor vehicle or aircraft, personal property of another, etc.
Part II Crimes	
<b>Animal Control</b>	<i>Definition:</i> Reports involving animal (primarily dog) issues, i.e. Animal Cruelty, Animal Bites, Stray Dogs, Dangerous Animals, Public Nuisance Calls Relating to Animals
<b>Domestic Violence</b>	<i>Definition:</i> Violent or aggressive behavior within the home which includes victims such as: Spouses, Dating/Intimate partners, Family members, Children, Cohabitants
<b>Assaults</b>	<i>Definition:</i> An unlawful attack by one person upon another where the victim is injured or placed in reasonable apprehension of injury. Does not involve a weapon or serious injury
<b>Vandalism/Criminal Damage</b>	<i>Definition:</i> To willfully or maliciously destroy, injure, disfigure, or deface any public or private property
Miscellaneous	
<b>Response time</b>	<i>Definition:</i> The average length of time in minutes and seconds for the first unit to arrive to the scene of priority two and three calls. (high priority)
<b>Overdose</b>	<i>Definition:</i> Overdose Calls is a total and includes both Deaths and Narcan Saves.
